FoxAuto designs automation that asks for approval when actions are privileged — scheduling without silent power.

What it is

Workflow orchestration concepts: triggers, gates, execution logs, and human confirmation for consequential steps.

Definitions describe triggers and steps. High-impact actions route through approval. Logs retain who confirmed what.
