Mission

FoxData treats data movement as a governed pipeline: validate early, retain lineage, export only what policy allows.

What it is

FoxData covers ingestion, validation, transformation, indexing, and export patterns for teams that must respect residency and audit expectations.

Core Capabilities

- Schema validation patterns
- Lineage-oriented metadata
- Export control checklists
- Index strategies for operator search

Use Cases

- Ingest pilots
- Export-controlled reporting
- Search index rebuilds

Technology

Architecture

Stages are explicit: ingest → validate → transform → store → index → query → export. Metadata carries lineage notes so operators can answer “where did this field come from?”

Security Posture

Datasets are access-scoped. Public JSON is never a substitute for authorization. Path isolation protects storage roots.
