Mission

FoxEdge designs for the place work actually happens — shops, branches, devices — where latency and offline time are normal.

What it is

Edge placement, sync conflict policies, and resilience patterns for distributed execution.

Core Capabilities

- Offline-first application patterns
- Sync and conflict policy sketches
- Edge placement guidance
- Latency budget worksheets

Architecture

Edge nodes hold limited blast radius. Sync strategies are explicit about conflict winners. Central systems remain optional enhancers.

Security Posture

Local secrets stay local. Compromise of one edge node must not unlock the fleet.
